

Box Springs Cooperative Parish Wishes a Special Warm Welcome To Pastor Tom and Tha Tran

Tom Tran was born and raised in a Christian home in Vietnam. He accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior at the age of twelve. In April 1975, North Vietnamese communist troops invaded and took over South Vietnam by force. They took Tom's father, who was a colonel of South Vietnamese army, to concentration camp for ten years. Tom's family suffered religious and political persecution under communist rule. Between 1977 and 1982, Tom tried to escape Vietnam by boat seven times. But all of the efforts failed and he was caught and put in communist prison three times! Right after his latest release, Tom escaped again with fifty others in a small and old river boat which was 30 foot long and 10 foot wide with a small engine! After five days, they reached the shore of Thailand in March 1982. Tom lived in two refugee camps for 18 months before being resettled in the U.S. in November 1983.

This escaping experience has led him to say yes to God's call to ministry. Rev. Tran completed his theological education at Pacific Christian College and Claremont School of Theology. In June 1994, he was ordained and sent to full time ministry by Bishop Roy Sano. Since then, he has served eight churches. Rev. Tran loves the church and the people whom he serves. His gifts and graces are in the area of leadership, preaching, teaching and pastoral care. He also has a strong commitment to evangelism.






